Training - Expedition & Outdoor Leadership (Basic level)

Taking place in Motherwell over three different dates (30th January, 6th February & 6th March 2018), the training course leads to the awarding of the BASIC Certificate in Expedition and Outdoor Leadership. The course is aimed at those that are new to E&OL and interested in getting young people outdoors. The course includes six hours of theory over three evenings, followed by a hike/over-night camp in the open season (April/May/June 2018). On gaining the BASIC certificate the leader will be equipped to teach and lead accompanied training expeditions in moderate and familiar terrain and in doing so, gain experience.
